

Nationally, there were 2,526 gun deaths in 2022 among 1- to 17-year-olds.²

In Wilmington in 2025, youth made up 18% of shooting incidents and 13% of shooting victims.³

In 2022, Delaware schools had eight gun incidents, which was more than double any year over the previous five years.⁴
