We unite communities, philanthropic organizations, healthcare systems, and government agencies to address the urgent issue of community gun violence. **ECVN bridges public safety and economic mobility—creating safer communities and stronger labor pipelines.**

- Convene community violence intervention (CVI) organizations, workforce providers, employers, and government partners.
- Align funding, metrics, and implementation across systems.
- Ensure workforce strategies are trauma-informed, culturally responsive, and community-driven.
- Translate employer needs into accessible pathways for CVI-connected participants.
